### SEASON:

The season will begin on Saturday, June 19, 2004 and will end Saturday, August 7, 2004. There will be eight games.

### GAMES:

All games will be played on Saturdays at Foothill Middle School, 2775 Cedro Lane, Walnut Creek. Cedro Lane runs between N. Wiget and Oak Grove Rd. WCYAA will attempt to schedule as many games as possible in the morning hours.

### PRACTICE:

All coaches will be allowed to practice once a week. The site will be determined by each team based on convenience of location.
